








 <small>THE WORLD IN YOUR GLASS</small> 93/100 Roger Voss	This is a juicy, fruity wine that's supported by dark fruit tannins. The black currant fruits are bright and crisp, while the structure is firm and the finish lingering.
 92-93/100 James Suckling	This is very balanced and fine with blueberry, black currants, and licorice. Medium to full body, integrated tannins and a clean finish. Sexy.
 <small>The Independent Consumer's Guide to Fine Wines</small> 90-92/100 Neal Martin	The 2015 Château Pédesclaux is a blend of 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot and 6% Petit Verdot, incidentally the first time that the latter has been used in the blend. It was picked from 18 September with the young Merlot and finished 26 October with the Cabernet Sauvignon at 50hl/ha. It has a very pure bouquet with iodine-tinged blueberry and blackberry fruit, graceful and harmonious. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, precise in the mouth with perhaps the best tension that I have discerned in this rejuvenated Pauillac – one where a pretty penny has been spent, I might add. Granted, this is not a Pédesclaux with profound depth and I was anticipating greater volume. That said, it is nicely proportioned and sure to age well, continuing the vigorous upward curve of this estate. One to watch.
 90/100 Jeff Leve	The new kid on the block in Pauillac has produced a ripe, elegant, sweet, polished charmer with plenty of cassis and dusty tannins in the finish. This is an estate to watch as they have an owner with a spare no expense attitude who has already completed a new cellar and is beginning to replant much of the vineyard, getting the right vines into the correct soil type.
 90/100 Steven Spurrier	A good broad Cabernet cassis nose and palate that is nicely lifted. A modern wine that is on the way up, showing fine fruit, character and charm.
 18/20	Le petit verdot fait son entrée dans l'assemblage de ce 2015. Il amplifie les arômes de violette et d'épices, complétés dans le cèdre et le havane. Quelle palette d'arômes !
